After Carlton he played and assisted coaching at the Doncaster Sharks for 2 years and in 2017 was appointed Senior Coach for his original club Darley - in the Ballarat League. The Darley Devils beat arch rival Bacchus Marsh in the 2017 Grand Final with Heath also being a standout player in his last game as a player. He was named coach of the year and was also in the team of the year \$40 + Drinks in the Ballarat League.
